A 10 STEP RCL STATUS:

- #1 Our first concern is the wellbeing of our consumers
- **#2** We are deeply concerned about the tragic outbreak of listeriosis and are working closely with various Government departments to resolve the issue.
- The specific "Listeria monocytogenes ST6" [dangerous] strain of listeria has **not** been linked to our Wolwehoek manufacturing facility
- We adhere to strict food safety protocols across all our manufacturing sites our facilities are FSSC 22000 or #4 ISO 22000 compliant.
- As a precautionary measure, the government has issued a recall notice for all Rainbow polony products, although test results of environmental samples are still **#5** outstanding.
- #6 RCL FOODS has ordered, as a precautionary measure, a recall of all its polony products from the entire customer base
- **#7** RCL FOODS recall concerns polony, **not fresh or frozen** chicken.
- #8 Other processed Rainbow products (Freezer to Fryer, MCP, Fully Cooked) are not affected
- **Cooked food is safe.** Cooking at heat above 70 degrees #9 kills listeriosis
- **#10** There has been some confusion in the press Enterprise is **not** owned by RCL FOODS.
