

B-BBEE SCORECARD

The following example illustrates the benefit to your B-BBEE Scorecard on Preferential Procurement when you buy from Food Trucks.

If a customer procures 40% of their basket from Food Trucks and 60% from non-compliant suppliers.

(Food Trucks is level 3 verified, more than 51% Black owned and more than 30% Black woman owned) *For the example we have assumed that a customers total purchases are R1 000.00
